



Teen Masters National Finalist Corporate Partnership Program

For many the challenge won't be bowling well enough in a regional qualifying event to earn an invitation to the 2010 Teen Masters Championships in Reno. That will be the easy part. The real challenge will be putting together the funds to get there. What can be done? Introducing the **Teen Masters National Finalist Corporate Partnership Program!**

Through the Teen Masters National Finalist Corporate Partnership Program, the Teen Masters is giving local and regional companies the opportunity to showcase their community commitment and social responsibility by sponsoring a national finalist (aka You) in the amounts of \$500, \$250, and \$100. In plain English, identify someone to partner with you such as your bank, your grocery store, your dry cleaners, your insurance agent, etc., we will give them exposure through the resources of the Teen Masters, and you will receive funds to help cover your Teen Masters expenses. Consider it a Teen Masters stimulus package!

The program will allow you to receive reimbursement of the following:

- The Teen Masters **registration fee**.
- A Teen Masters **hotel package** at Circus Circus, Eldorado or Silver Legacy including additional nights purchased through the Teen Masters rate.
- **Air fare** for a bowler and one (1) accompanying parent/guardian (maximum of \$600 per ticket) or reimbursement of **\$0.50 per mile** roundtrip for those who drive.
- **Meal allowance** for a bowler and one (1) accompanying parent/guardian of \$46 per day per person. (Will be based on number of nights booked at the partnering hotels).

To participate in the program you will need the following:

1. **Register**. Sign up for the National Finals on TeenMastersBowling.com by paying your \$397 registration fee. Your name will now be visible to potential corporate partners.
2. **Receipts**. Submit your receipts via a form that will be provided to you. Receipts will be needed for your Teen Masters **hotel package** and **airfares**, but not for the registration fee, meals or gasoline expenses as they are standardized.
3. **Parent/Guardian PayPal Account**. Your parent or guardian will need to have a PayPal account (setting up one is free on PayPal.com). Within seven (7) days of receiving the required receipts, the Teen Masters will electronically transfer the sponsorship funds received on your behalf, up to the total of your allowed expenses, to your parent's/guardian's PayPal account. *If your sponsorship funds exceed your allowed expenses, the balance will be donated to Special Olympics in your name.*

Please do not approach Kegel, Dexter, or Ebonite for sponsorship. they are already doing more than their fair share.
